

## **Neighbourhood Watch – Smart Water Update September 2017.**

During the past few months Ombersley and Doverdale Neighbourhood Watch Team have been working with the Warwickshire and West Mercia “We Don’t buy crime” team and a product called Smart Water.

The result being that during October approximately 50 houses in Uphampton will be the first area in Ombersley and Doverdale to become a Smart Water area.

This will be followed by several other areas working to achieve the Parish’s goal of 75% of households within the Parish.
